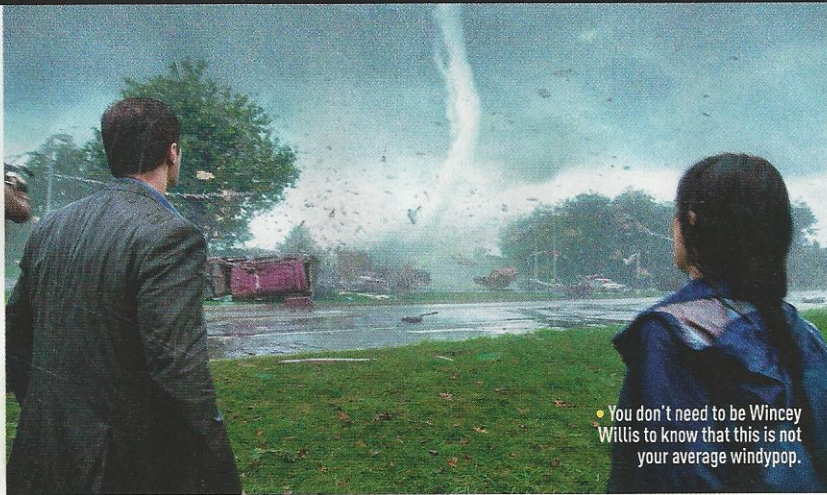
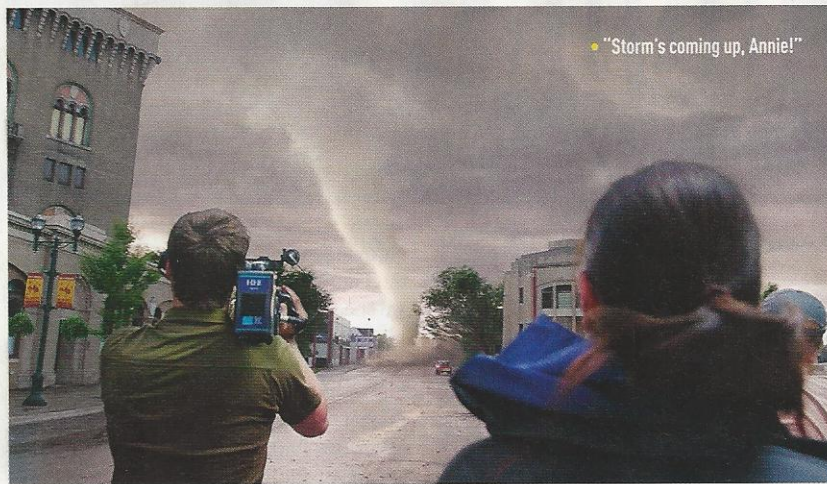


# WINDY VILLAINS

• This is a firenado. A tornado made of fire. This is a real thing. Gulp.

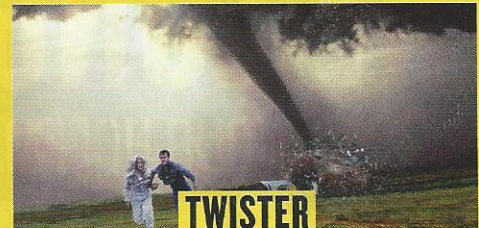

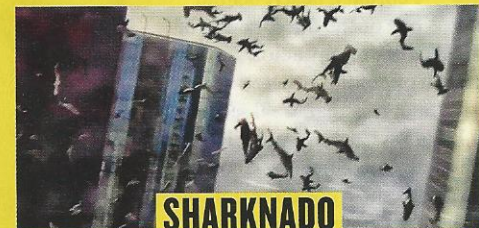
## THE WIZARD OF OZ

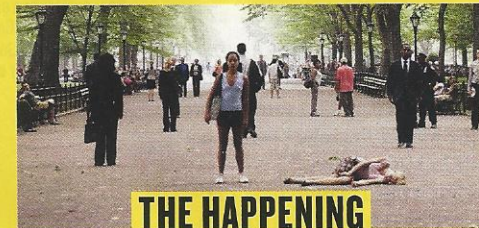
## TWISTER

A massive storm hits a small American town. Good for the marriage status of two chasers, played by Bill Paxton and Helen Hunt, but terrible for cows.



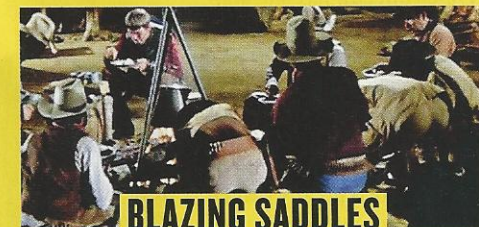
## SHARKNADO
